From the Prez

What a show! I just got back from the annual pilgrimage to Oshkosh and EAA Airventure. Lots of walking and lots of airplanes. This year's airshow featured an aerobatic helicopter. Yep, he was capable of loops and rolls with it. It was not real showy, but when you looked and realized what he was doing you went WOW.

Other highlights from the show were the Boeing Dreamlifter. This is Boeing's transporter to ferry parts for the new 787 Dreamliner. Parts for the 787 are being built all over the world and assembled in Seattle. Also making its debut at Oshkosh was the V-22 Osprey Tilt Rotor Aircraft. I was expecting a noisy aircraft and a sound more like a helicopter. I was surprised as to how quiet it was. On the other end of the sound scale was the AV8 Harrier and the F-22 Raptor. The Raptor was much louder in my opinion than the Harrier. The F-22 performed a tail slide and then powered up and climbed out at one point of its routine. Unfortunately because of airspace restrictions the Raptor couldn't do its full demonstration, but it was still awesome.

One of the more interesting announcements from Airventure was the unveiling of White Knight Two by Scaled Composites (Burt Rutan), and Virgin Galactic (Sir Richard Branson). White Knight Two is the plane to launch Space Ship Two on suborbital flights. It was announced and that White Knight Two will be making an appearance at Oshkosh 2009. The best though was that when the first commercial space flights are ready to be launched, they will happen at Airventure during the daily airshow. The place is going to be a zoo when that happens.

Our Fly-In is about a month away. The August meeting will be the last planing meeting before the event. There will be quite a bit to talk about and your input is important.

That's all for this month. Get out and fly. Hope to see you at the meeting.

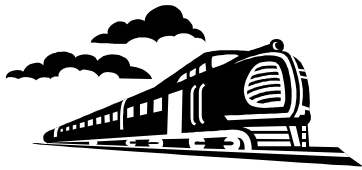
