### Remedy for Poor Idle

You can get the idle problem solved simply. Put a one way in line choke valve (a couple of \$ in any hobby store) between the muffler and the tank. That way, when the engine is at full throttle and there is good backpressure in the muffler, that pressure is also in the tank. When you idle, the choke prevents the air from the tank to go back to the muffler, therefore maintaining the same high pressure in the tank as before. This WILL solve many fuel draw problems at idle.

Navigation and landing lights for model airplanes and helicopters. Led 5mm light set will include a Green and Red wing tip markers, Red and White strobe lights for tail and tail areas, one White landing light. All lights operate on 4.8 – 6V DC and draw aprox 500Mah. Lights are pre-wired in lengths of 36 and 48 inch leads. Custom lengths are available upon request.

These lights can generate light as bright as a 50w light bulb and have a life length of aprox 100,000 hrs. They are visible in daylight at aprox 150 ft.

Also available is a Servo switch that will operate on any unused channel and can be turned on and off by the transmitter. The Servo switch is a solid-state device and can handle current up to 6A.

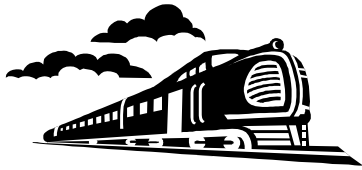
