## From the Prez

I see by recent emails that the airfield is accessible by road. I hope that is a good sign that winter will soon be over and we can once again be out enjoying our hobby. I'm sure that many of you are as anxious as I am to get out and try out our winter builds or acquisitions.

As an aside I will make note that I have been receiving many emails about proposed government regulations directed at our hobby. I'm sure many of you are receiving the same notes encouraging action to help ensure the proposed regulations by the FAA do not unnecessarily restrict or inhibit operations of model aircraft under proposed regulations for Small Unmanned Aerial Systems (sUAS). The AMA has sent out information about the proposals and made recommendations for the elimination of model aircraft from the sUAS regulation proposals.

The rationale being that they are unnecessary and burdensome. They encourage everyone to contact their representatives to voice a concern and recommend that model aircraft be removed from the sUAS proposals.

While I generally try not to express my personal view on such causes. I do however feel that this one merits mentioning to our group. I have reviewed the published proposal and will only summarize it by this. The sUAS regulation as proposed will have significant impact on the hobby and operations of model aircraft. Far beyond any previous restrictions. If enacted it will require that we review the rules and restrictions for flying at our airfield. I leave it up to you to decide for yourself if you want to support the AMA's recommendation or take any action. The AMA web site has some example letters to send to representatives.

Here's wishing for early spring and good flying weather.
