The cost of printing had also become inflated (up to 30¢ per page, the newsletter is usually between 2 and 5 pages). . .</li> </ol>	<p>Our membership usually numbers around 50 each year. So you can see the cost in just the production</p> <p>4.) The task of producing the newsletter in print vs. email and posting on the web site is considerably greater and time consuming for the newsletter editor who must collate, produce labels and mail them</p> <p>Options: Some have already chosen to mitigate the fee by providing the club newsletter editor an appropriate number of self addressed stamped envelopes. This is a perfectly acceptable remedy for those who wish to have the newsletter mailed to them thereby avoiding the fee. Please feel free to exercise this option if you wish.</p> <p>Primarily, I believe this ruling was made to preserve the clubs budget and operating costs so we may ensure we can continue to provide and maintain our terrific flying site.</p> <p>While some have reflected concern over the additional fee it will stand. 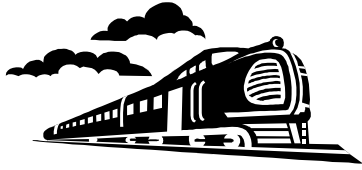
