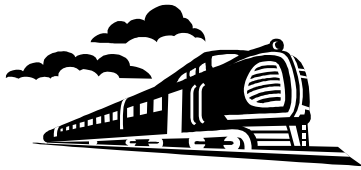
Larry Barnes has become our new Safety Officer. We welcome Larry to his new position where we know he will do well.
