### watt per pound table:

25 watts-per-pound - airplane is typically hand-launched and won't do much more than just fly around  
50 watts-per-pound - airplane is hand-launched, would ROG off of hard surfaces, and perform mild aerobatics  
75 watts-per-pound - airplane would ROG off of a grass field, climb well, and perform nice aerobatics  
100 watts-per-pound - airplane would nearly go straight up, can handle all the aerobatics

To measure the wattage of a motor you multiply the voltage x current. Example:

### Park Zone 480 brushless motor

Battery	propeller	voltage	amps	wattage
(1800mAh Li-Po)	PZ 9.5x7.5	11.1	18.0 amps	199.8 watts.
