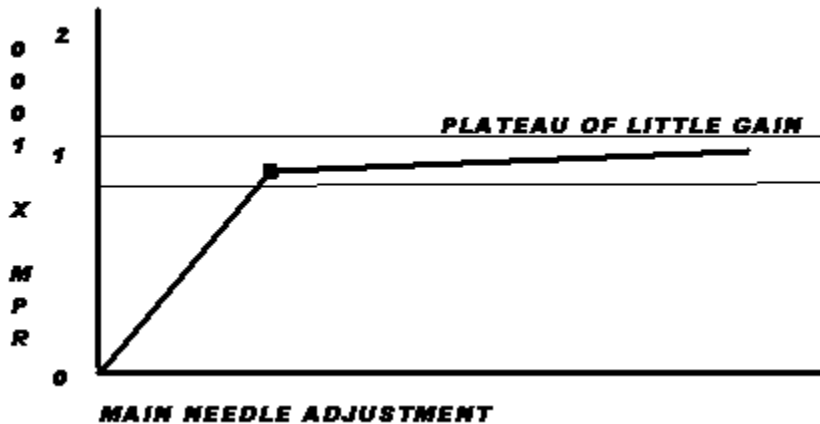

FINDING THE SWEET SPOT

Whenever I tune a 4-stroke engine, I visualize this simple graph and it always leads Me to the place I want to be – **at maximum power with a margin of safety**. As you close the main needle, you'll see a very noticeable gain in RPM. As you continue to Close the needle, the gain in RPM will be far less noticeable because you are on the “plateau of little gains”. At this point, you'll gain only a few hundred RPM. Whenever you find yourself there, back off and return to the “sweet spot”

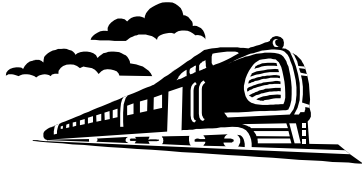
